








#1 This Old Man



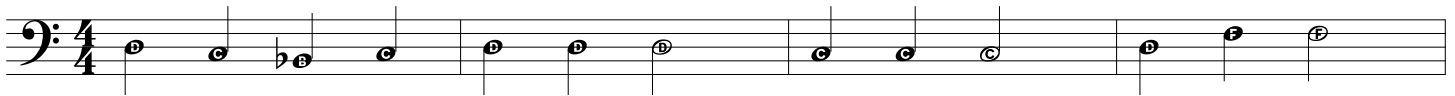
This old man, He played one, He played nick - nack

Mer - ri - ly we roll a - long, roll a - long, roll a - long.

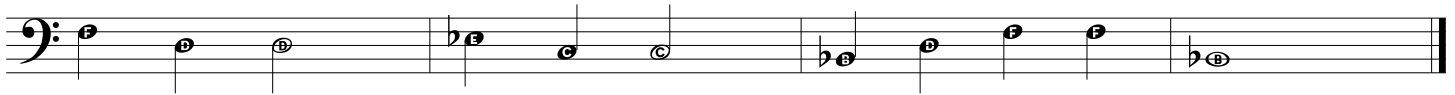
